Supreme Court Launches New Judicial Learning Center Website

The Wyoming Supreme Court has launched a new Judicial Learning Center website, which can be accessed at jlc.wyo.gov. The Judicial Learning Center opened on January 9, 2017, and is located in the Wyoming Supreme Court, State Law Library. Attorneys, teachers, students, and others may now access Judicial Learning Center games and resources online. The website is broken into four major categories: Learn, Play, Resources, and Contact. Online visitors can watch the *Rule of Law* film, play *You Be the Judge*, explore an interactive map of *Wyoming's Court Systems*, listen to a justice or judge by clicking on *Hear from a Judge* or test their skills at *Applying the Rule of Law*. Online visitors may download games like the *Preamble Scramble* and eventually access lesson plans from the resources tab. The website also allows teachers and other groups the ability to book a Judicial Learning Center visit directly from the site.

“It was always our goal, and the goal of the legislature, to make Judicial Learning Center exhibits and content accessible to students statewide, without them having to travel to Cheyenne. The Judicial Learning Center is now accessible to everyone regardless of their location.” Chief Justice Burke said.
