JUDICIAL NOMINATING COMMISSION ANNOUNCES

NOMINEES FOR THE VACANCY IN THE DISTRICT COURT, EIGHTH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (DOUGLAS)

On behalf of the Judicial Nominating Commission, Wyoming Supreme Court Chief Justice E. James Burke, who serves as chairman, announced today that the commission has completed its consideration of all who have expressed interest in the position of District Court Judge in the Eighth Judicial District. Pursuant to Article 5, § 4 of the Wyoming Constitution, the Judicial Nominating Commission submitted three nominees for the position to Governor Matthew H. Mead for his consideration. Those nominees, listed in alphabetical order, are:

Edward A. Buchanan
Kerri M. Johnson
F. Scott Peasley

Governor Mead has thirty days to appoint one of these three nominees to serve as the new District Court Judge. Current members of the Judicial Nominating Commission are three lawyers elected by the Wyoming State Bar: P. Craig Silva of Casper, Richard H. Honaker of Rock Springs, and Professor John M. Burman of Laramie; and three non-lawyers appointed by the Governor: Lori A. Emmert of Douglas, Teri Bowers of Grover, and Rosie Berger of Big Horn.
